² In the 2016 survey, question wording was, "Do you personally know anyone who is transgender, or not?" The response options were, "Yes, I know someone who is transgender" and "No, I do not." In this survey, "transgender" was defined as "people who now identify and live as females but were born male" and "people who now identify and live as males but were born female."
